20 YEARS OF PROVIDING SERVICES FREE-OF-CHARGE FOR OLDER ADULTS IN RURAL CASS



For twenty years, Community of Care has been serving older adults throughout the 1,700 square mile area of rural Cass County! We began serving clients through our Arthur in 2003. The Casselton office and volunteer transportation program was added in 2005. During those 20 years, we have assisted older adults with information, referrals for service, Medicare Part D drug

plan enrollment, help completing fuel/food/Medicaid applications, transportation to medical appointments, education and socialization events. Faith Community Nurse (FCN) program was added in 2012. Our FCNs provide outreach visits to help older adults understand health conditions, doctor's orders and medications. Bone Builder classes are held in 6 locations in rural Cass.

What began 20 years ago has grown to serve greater number of clients and greater needs. Our programs and services have always been based on the needs of our clients.

When Community of Care started in 2003, the decision was made to provide our services FREE-OF-CHARGE! In 2023, that continues to be the case—we DO NOT CHARGE for services, regardless of a person's economic situation.

You might wonder how we are able to provide our programs and services. Thanks to many grantors and donors (see the list

HEALTH CORNER

Hearing loss affects many individuals. It can be frustrating and people may hesitate to raise their concerns. Recent research from John Hopkins reveals it can also be linked to falls, walking problems, social isolation and dementia. Frank Lin, M.D., Ph.D. from John Hopkins and his colleagues traced 639 adults for nearly 12 years. They found that mild hearing loss doubled dementia risk. Moderate loss tripled risk, and people with severe hearing impairment were five times more likely to develop dementia. On average, hearing aid users wait 10 years before getting help for hearing loss. Communication, isolation and health risks can increase during those 10 year.

If you or a loved one is experience hearing loss, we encourage you to speak to your physician. Our goal at Community of Care is for older adults to have the highest quality of life. Improved hearing might be a step towards improving your health. Contact Community of Care if you need assistance finding a doctor or audiologist.



COMMUNITY OF CARE IS EXPANDING!

We are **THRILLED** to announce the addition of a **part-time Faith Community Nurse (FCN)** to serve in the Kindred and Leonard area. The addition of a 10-12 hour/week FCN in the southern part of rural Cass will allow Community of Care to serve greater number of clients and greater needs. Our FCNs are licensed RNS who provide outreach visits to assist clients understand their health conditions, medications and physician’s orders. They also provide referrals for in-home services and equipment. Applications are currently being accepted. Contact Myrna at 701/347-0032 to learn more. The support we continue to receive from donors and grantors allow us to provide this important addition to our services. Our goal is to have the Kindred/Leonard FCN start in January 2024.
