Did you know that when we provide services, such as a ride to a medical appointment, it makes a difference for our clients, their families and our volunteers? Carolyn Lewis receives rides from Community of Care. When asked what it means to her, this was her response, *"It mean's the world to me, because my children can't always take me where I need to go and I need Community of Care. They are wonderful."*

Ken Astrup is one of our volunteers, and also recently joined the Board of Directors. Ken's reply to why he decided to volunteer was, *"I did some research on Community of Care and I liked what they are doing. I enjoy the people I get to travel and meet with, we get to visit on the ride. It's surprising how small the world is with the people we both know."*

A ride to a medical appointment is a vital element in older adults ability to remain in their home. **Without that ride, they might not receive the medical care they need, or they might have to move from the rural home and community they love.**

A ride to the appointment is also a social outing. Our clients and volunteers visit and build relationships as they travel down the highway together. Carolyn was asked



about our volunteer Ken and she quickly replied, *"He is irreplaceable!"* That is a very similar response to what Community of Care hears about all of our volunteers. **The services we provide, including the rides, make a difference for family members too.** Carolyn's daughter Kathy had this reply when asked what C of Care mean's to them, *"As adult children, we try to be there for our parents, but we can't always be there. Without Community of Care, I don't know what choices we might have. We are incredibly blessed to have Community of Care in our community!"*

Kathy's response is similar to many adult children and it doesn't just represent rides to medical appointments. Many adult children tell us they don't know where to turn to care for their aging parents and they are very grateful for all the services Community of Care provides.

DO YOU HAVE A HEART TO VOLUNTEER, TIME TO PROVIDE A RIDE AND A RELIABLE VEHICLE?

For many of our older adult clients, a ride to a medical appointment is a vital element in their ability to remain in their rural home. In our most recent client survey, 83% of our clients reported the ride assists them to remain in their rural home. January through October



2025, we have facilitated 239 rides to medical appointments. This includes 12,796 miles driven and 862 hours of volunteer

services. We could not provide this important services without our dedicated volunteers. Kenny Hochhalter from Arthur is one of our dedicated volunteer drivers. We are always looking for more volunteers to provide these rides. Volunteers drive when it fits their schedule. To learn more give our Volunteer Coordinator Natalie a call 701-347-0032. Ready or not, winter is going to arrive in the Red River Valley. Most of us have experienced many winters, but it is always a good idea to

be reminded of some winter safety issues to consider.

Here are a few things to review for yourself or an older adult in your life:

- Stay **indoors during bad weather** or extreme cold
- **Keep your cell phone charged** for when you are in the car, but also when you are at home in the event your landline stops working
- Keep a **winter safety kit in your vehicle** – boots, gloves, scarf, warm clothes, blanket, snacks, etc.
- Make sure you are **adequately dressed for winter conditions** (warm coat, gloves, boots, hat)
- Listen to local **weather reports before leaving home and while on the road**. All of us know weather can change quickly in North Dakota
- **Let someone know your travel plans**, even if just to town for appointments or errands
- **Add grippers to your shoes** or walking device to help prevent falls on ice and snow
- If you use a **walker or cane**, be sure to use them for your safety walking on snow on ice
- Make sure you have **extra food and medication** at home in the event you are stranded in your home
- Have **flashlights available and extra batteries** in event of power outage
- If you are **on oxygen**, have a back-up plan for a power outage
- If you have a power recliner or lift chair, **how will you get out of the chair in a power outage**

We want everyone to be safe this winter. A reminder that Community of Care facilitates rides to medical appointments for older adults. Call our office to request a ride 701-347-0032. If you are a new transportation client, you will need to complete paperwork prior to receiving a ride.

CHARITABLE REQUESTS

A charitable bequest is one of the easiest and most flexible ways to leave a gift to your favorite charities.

- Name a charity in your will (you can specify a piece of property, a percentage of your total estate, or a gift contingent on certain events)
- You leave a lasting legacy for your favorite charities while lessening the tax burden on your heirs



You can transfer funds from your IRA directly to charity while reducing your taxable income. In 2025, you can avoid taxes on transfers up to \$108,000 per person. Qualified Charitable Distributions can meet your Required Minimum Distribution requirement if you are 70 1/2, while providing tax benefits.

NORTH DAKOTA 40% ENDOWMENT TAX CREDIT

ND residents who make a donation of \$5,000 or more to a qualified endowment receive a state tax credit, which can be carried over for 3 tax years. The maximum donation per year is \$10,000 per individual and \$20,000 per couple.

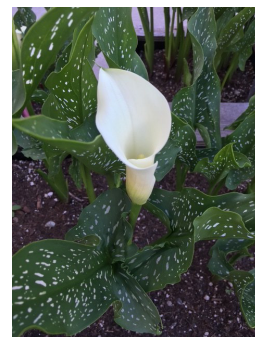
